Chui Tze Hung trained in Hong Kong with Lui Shou Kwan, a forerunner of the first wave of Modernist painting in the nineteen fifties.

Chui Tze Hung brought a decisive contribution to the revival of Chinese painting in the XXth century.

Although his painting is rooted in Chinese tradition, it cannot be denied it borrows from the great Western art movements. This can be seen in his geometric designs, colour contrasts, and the use of collage.

Chui Tze Hung has combined all the features of classic Chinese works - in medium, format and technique - with one of the founding ideas of modern art : Abstraction.
